_____ <b>Safe</b> _____	I use the computer in my kitchen or family room.
_____ <b>Not safe</b> _____	While I am at my friend's house, I don't have to follow my parent's rules about using the computer.
_____ <b>Safe</b> _____	I ask my parents if I can meet an online friend.
_____ <b>Safe</b> _____	I delete an email message from someone I don't know.
_____ <b>Not safe</b> _____	Kids from school sent me an email that made me uncomfortable, so I wrote a mean message back to them.
